They took part in many activities during the day: learning how to make a clippy mat as part of the make do and mend efforts; weighing out sweet rations (3oz a week!); learning how potatoes were used to make food stretch further and listened to an evacuee, who told his story of what it had really been like to move away from his parents at the age of 11.
