Foundation Stage Spring Topics

The Weather

Our 'Weather' topic offers children the opportunity to begin talking about different weather conditions and explore how it is important to wear different clothing during these different weather conditions.

People who help us

This is a wide-ranging topic with plenty of opportunity to make connections between people and places. It includes every aspect of the local community, from friends to child-minders and from shopkeepers to fire fighters. We aim to invite adults who fulfill helpful roles to visit us in school bringing the topic to life for children. It is also ideal for discussing how we can help others.

Early Phonics

This term, we play lots of 'Letters & Sounds' games, which help us to listen carefully and talk about what we hear, see and do. We are starting to think about the sounds at the beginning of our names and then find other objects that begin with the same sound. We also have been starting to play 'Silly Soup' a rhyming game.

Going on a Bear Hunt

To finish off our bear topic all 'Foundation Stage' will be attending a stage performance of 'Going on a Bear Hunt' at Billingham Forum on 24/1/17 or 25/1/17. Details to follow.
