Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have had an enjoyable Easter break and, like us, are looking forward to the term ahead! We would like to take this opportunity to share with you some of the exciting things that Year 3 children will be doing over the term.

This term we will be studying the Ancient Romans and linking this to many areas of the curriculum.

English
The Romans provide a stimulus for a number of exciting writing opportunities in English. After exploring a selection of texts and writing, we will be using this knowledge to write different genres. For example, this half term the children will be creating an information text, 'All about Ancient Rome' and a narrative story based on a Roman myth or legend. Next half term, they will write a diary entry based on the experiences of a Gladiator and writing a newspaper article.

Maths
Our focuses for this term include securing number facts, place value, understanding and applying the written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, solving multi-step problems, comparing and ordering fractions, interpreting graphs and charts and understanding measures— weight, length and capacity. The children will continue to learn their tables daily and complete daily mental maths.

Science
Our Science work for this term is researching 'Forces' and 'Plants'. We will be investigating how plants grow in different conditions in order to find out what plants need to flourish. We will also be finding out, through exploration and investigations, about forces and how objects move.

Computing
Children will be working with a variety of devices to develop the skill of coding and programming as well as using the devices for research based tasks. The children will also be using the laptops and Ipads to carry out research on the Romans and produce a fact-file, including text and pictures.

Music
In Music, children will continue to develop their music theory during our weekly recorder lessons.



Geography / History
In History, the children will learn about famous Roman emperors and understand key times and events, including why the Romans invaded Britain. They will explore the life of a Roman soldier. They will use a range of resources and media to do this.

Design Technology and Art
In D&T we will be using a range of media to design and produce a Roman chariot and we will also explore Roman Art. The children will design and create a Mosaic tile. We will also study Vincent Van Gogh and develop our sketching skills.

P.S.H.E/RRSA
This term we will be continuing to learn about Rights and Responsibilities and the UNCRC. Our PSHE activities this term are "Relationships" and "Changes".

Physical Education
In P.E. this term we will be following a topic called "Take Aim". The children will develop skills including; choosing appropriate techniques for throwing and being able to select the correct equipment. Next half term, will be practising athletics.

Religious Education
In R.E. we will be finding out about Holy books and why they are important. Also, the children will look at how Jesus' parables help Christians live their lives.

French
The children will be participating in French lessons to develop their speaking and listening skills through language games.
