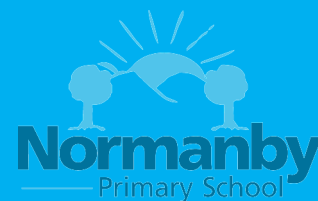




'Feelgood' Friday Newsletter
