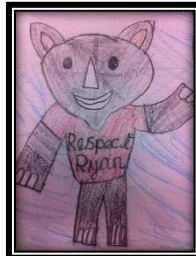

#### Article of the Month

Every month we focus on one article from the UNCRC. The Rights Leaders group have looked at what is happening over the school year and selected the article for each month themselves. These will be shared in assemblies and taught as part of our curriculum.

#### **April: Article 32**

Governments must protect children from work that is dangerous or might harm their health/education.

#### **May: Article 12**

Every child has the right to have a say in all matters affecting them, and to have their views taken seriously.

#### **June: Article 15**

Every child has the right to meet with other children and to join groups and organisations.

#### **July: Article 29**

Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to the full.

#### What is the Role of a Rights Leader?

- Have a strong voice in the classroom and the wider school and ensure other children do too.
- Help to create a rights respecting culture in all classrooms and around school.
- Help to create opportunities to promote children's rights within and beyond the school.
