Free School Meals Applications Important Notes

Parents/Guardians will no longer be required to send a copy of their benefit evidence to support their claim.

We will check your entitlement on the Free School Meals Eligibility Checking Service where data is held by the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP), Her Majesty's Revenues and Customs and the Home Office. If the Department for Education's Eligibility Checking Service is unable to confirm that you are entitled to Free School Meals, it will be necessary for us to ask you to provide evidence.

If you are in receipt of one of the following you may qualify for Free School Meals: -

Income Support Income Based Jobseekers Allowance Income Related Employment and Support Allowance The Guaranteed Element of Pension Credit Support under part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 Universal Credit - with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400 Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs of no more than £16,190) Working Tax Credit 'Run On' – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

It should be noted that if you are entitled to Working Tax Credit on a regular basis you will not qualify for free school meals.

Transitional Protection

From 1 April 2018, all existing free school meals claimants will continue to receive free school meals whilst Universal Credit is rolled out. This will apply even if their earnings rise above the new threshold during that time.

In addition, any child gaining eligibility for free school meals after 1 April 2018 will be protected against losing free school meals during the Universal Credit rollout period.

Once Universal Credit is fully rolled out, any existing claimants that no longer meet the above eligibility criteria at that point will continue to receive free school meals until the end of their current phase of education (i.e. primary or secondary). Transitional Protection applies to all children whether eligible through legacy benefits or Universal Credit.

Transitional Protections are put in place on an individual child basis, not on a family basis. This means that younger children will not become entitled to free school meals simply because their older sibling is in receipt of transitional protection. The younger child must meet the eligibility criteria at the time the application is made to become eligible for free school meals.

The Universal Credit rollout is currently expected to complete in March 2022.
