FS2



In FS2, Reception came to school and dressed up in their favourite characters costume. They made a string of paper dolls from the Julia Donaldson book, paper dolls and decorated them with their favourite characters or members of their family. The children also made a bookmark with their favourite character on it. As well as all this, they listened to lots of stories and talked about the character they came as. Throughout the day they also made a bar chart about their favourite book and the favourite was the monster in my book.

Year 1

Year 2
