We aim to promote positive attitudes and encourage high standards of behaviour through these **three** school rules:

- **Be Safe**
- **Be Respectful**
- **Be Ready**

Reflection Sheets

Children who are not being **SAFE**, **RESPECTFUL** or **READY** will be reminded of our expectations.

We have also introduced 'Reflection Sheets' which link to these three rules. If unacceptable behaviour or incidents occur, children may be asked to complete a reflection sheet. This provides children with time to think carefully about their behaviour and actions and also gain the pupil's point of view.
