#### Books we are reading in KS2


Throughout Key Stage 2, pupils continue to be immersed in high quality books and texts linked to areas they are researching in class. As they become more confident and fluent readers, pupils will develop greater reading stamina and enjoy reading longer and more complex texts. Reading helps pupils to develop empathy and gain a deeper understanding of the world around them. When stories are read to them, at a higher level than they are able to read alone, pupils experience a wealth of vocabulary and become immersed in the lives of characters and experience a range of emotions.


