Uniform for next term

School Uniform is as shared in our website and PE kits will continue to be worn on the day children do PE. We have lots of nearly new uniform in school - please ask Miss Lawrence if you would like any help.

Our school PE kit is navy or dark jogging bottoms or leggings and a plain white t-shirt or polo shirt with a plain navy or dark jumper/hoody. **As it is worn in school all day as uniform, it is important that school PE uniform is worn**. Suitable footwear should be trainers. Please be aware that the children will use the field as much as possible in the summer term. It is useful for children to have a coat or separate extra layer for working outside on these days. Trainers that are suitable for the field are also advised. We try to keep PE days the same unless we have an unusual circumstance with staffing. Marvellous Me messages will update you of any changes to PE days or extra days where kit can be needed on additional days.

We would like to say goodbye and good luck to our Year 6 and wish them all the best in their new schools. Year 5 will be looking to set the same standard and will be ready to wear the ties that represent the high expectations we set and role models we expect them to be from our Year 6 children.
