This term Mr Faulkner will be working as the Head Teacher at Ormesby Primary school, another school in our trust. He will continue to be the Executive Head Teacher at Normanby Primary during this time.

Staff came back to school last week and as well as planning lots of exciting learning opportunities for this year, we discussed continuing the work we do to ensure that the children's behaviour is always great, so that we can focus on supporting them to learn and develop as respectful and kind individuals. ### Staffing Update

We are welcoming 2 new members of the teaching staff; Miss Moore is teaching in the Year 3 team. Miss Moore has already worked with many of our children last year, as a Tutor in our school, and Miss Manning who is new to school, is teaching in the Year 2 team. You will already know that Mrs Meadows, Miss Hodgson and Miss Peevor have worked with us last year and in the coming year; Mrs Meadows is teaching in the Year 3/4 team, Miss Hodgson is teaching in the Reception team and Miss Peevor joins the PE team.

#### **Dinner Money**

School dinners are £2.30 a day and £11.50 a week.

No cash payments are received in school.

All parents must use ParentPay. If you have any queries regarding this matter, please ask in the main school office. Please remember that all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to free school meals. If you have not already taken up this offer and would like to do so, please contact the main school office.

We will be sending out reminders to all children on Packed lunches about what should be in a healthy lunch and some suggestions. Please see our policy on the website.

Reminder that because we have a number of children in school with severe allergic reactions to some food products, we are unable to accept Birthday cake or sweets into school to share with other children.

## Water Bottles

All children will need to bring their own water bottle from home, preferably with their name on the bottle! The children will have an opportunity to top this up during the day.

### School Uniform

The children all look very smart wearing their school uniform today.

As a reminder, our uniform is as follows:

- Navy jumper,
- white shirt,
- grey or black trousers/skirt
- and sensible black leather shoes or trainers. If your child wears trainer style shoes the should be <u>completely</u> black.

Children may wear a watch and stud earrings, but no other jewellery may be worn. Prior to P.E. lessons the children will be asked to remove all jewellery themselves. I would suggest that on P.E. days the children do not wear earrings to school as this avoids hassle and saves time. During P.E. lessons long hair must be tied back.

There is no requirement to wear branded uniform.

School has several uniform items available for free; please contact the school Office if you think these might be of benefit to you.

Smart Watches are not suitable for school, so must not be worn.

### P.E. Kits

Check on Feelgood Friday Newsletter each week to check the day that your child should come to school in their PE kit.

For P.E. lessons your child will need:

- navy or black shorts,
- white tee shirt
- and trainers

If it is cold then the children can wear navy/black jogging bottoms, navy or black leggings, navy or black sweatshirt. Please note that children <u>may not</u> wear football kits in P.E. lessons or general leisure wear.

### Naming Clothes and Lost Property

Please help by ensuring that all property and items of clothing and footwear are clearly marked with your child's name.

### Mobile Phones

If a mobile phone is brought to school, these should be handed in to the teacher at the start of the day and may be collected at the end of the day. They are stored in a box when they have been switched off.
