Some activities to choose from...

Art DT Computing	With an adult, use the internet to find out about Paddington Bear. Write down some interesting facts about him to share in class.	Sketch Paddington Bear and then carefully colour or paint him. Remember we have practised shading at school!	With an adult, make a marmalade sandwich. Take photographs to show each of the different steps.
Writing	Draw Paddington Bear and label him e.g. ears, coat, eyes.	Write a list of things you will need to make a marmalade sandwich.	Write a set of instructions to explain to someone how to make a marmalade sandwich.
Maths	Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Can you count in odd numbers? Practise number bonds to 10 e.g. 1 + 9, 2 + 8, 3 + 7 Practise number bonds to 20 e.g. 1 + 19, 2 + 18, 3 + 17	Shape hunt – which shapes can you find in the house? Which 2d shapes can you find? Which 3d shapes can you find?	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Roll a Dice...</u></p> What happens when you add <i>even</i> numbers together? What happens when you add <i>odd</i> numbers together? What happens when you add <i>odd</i> and <i>even</i> numbers together? Practise adding and subtracting up to 20 e.g. 12 + 6
