## Some activities to choose from...

Reading	Writing	Maths
<p>Read a book from home and complete book review (what you liked/didn't like about the story)</p> <p>Identify words in your book that you don't recognise and find out their meaning</p> <p>Look for words containing specific sounds (e.g. ai – snail, ea – beach)</p> <p>Look for alternatively spelled sounds (e.g. ai, a_e, ay)</p>	<p>Create an alternative ending for a story or retell a Winnie the Witch story</p> <p>Write a description of a character or setting</p> <p>Write a diary from a character's point of view</p> <p>Research a different country and create a non-chronological report or fact file</p> <p>Write a recount about a happy memory</p> <p><b>Don't forget!!</b> Always use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops</p> <p>Use spelling knowledge</p>	<p>Identify number bonds within 100 (e.g. 70+30, 62+38, 55+45)</p> <p>Practise numbers to 100 in words and digits</p> <p>Complete simple arithmetic number sentences using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division</p> <p>'How many ways can you make ___' using addition <i>Challenge – use subtraction</i></p> <p>Estimate and measure objects around your home using centimetres and metres</p> <p>Go on a shape hunt around your house – look for 2D and 3D shapes</p>
